Regulation (EU) 2024/573 came into force in March 2024, repealing Regulation (EU) No 517/2014. This recast regulation imposes a number of requirements across the EU, aimed at minimising the use of F-Gases and products that contain F-Gases.

The new regulation imposes conditions on the production, import, export, placing on the market, subsequent supply and use of fluorinated greenhouse gases, and of specific products and equipment containing fluorinated greenhouse gases or whose functioning relies upon those gases. As a result of these changes, importers and exporters are required to input additional codes in data element 2/3 of the AIS customs declaration or data element 12.03 and 12.04 of the AES customs Declaration.

Both AIS and AES have been updated to enable these changes and allow data to be input to comply with the new controls.

## For your information:

- The importer and exporter of fluorinated greenhouse gases (Annexes I, II and III of Regulation (EU) 2024/573), and products and equipment containing those gases or whose functioning relies upon those gases shall hold a valid registration in the F-Gas Portal operated by the EU Commission, except in the case of temporary storage. This paragraph does not apply to products and equipment that are personal effects. (Article 22.1 of Regulation (EU) 2024/573).
- Fluorinated greenhouse gases imported into EU shall be considered as virgin gases. This means that sufficient hydrofluorocarbon (HFC) quota must be available on the importer's F-Gas Portal account when importing reclaimed HFCs.
- For the purposes of release for free circulation, the undertaking holding HFC quota or authorisations to use HFC quota as required under the F-Gas Regulation (EU) 2024/573 and registered in the F-gas Portal pursuant to Article 20, shall be the importer indicated in the customs declaration. (Article 23.3 of Regulation (EU) 2024/573).
- For the purposes of exports, the undertaking registered in the F-gas Portal pursuant to Article 20 shall be the exporter indicated in the customs declaration. (Article 23.3 of Regulation (EU) 2024/573).
- The placing on the market of products and equipment, including parts thereof, listed in Annex IV, shall be prohibited from the date specified in that Annex, differentiating, where applicable, according to the type or global warming potential of the gas contained. (Article 11.1 of Regulation (EU) 2024/573). There is an exemption for military equipment (Y986) and a conditional derogation for parts of products and equipment required for repair and servicing of existing equipment listed in Annex IV (Y152). Also, eco-designed equipment may qualify for an exemption (Article 11.2 of Regulation (EU) 2024/573) (Y986).
