


Automated Import System - AIS

AIS is Revenue's national import system that trade must use to lodge import declarations

Without **AIS**, it will not be possible to complete customs import formalities in respect of third-country goods into Ireland

AIS replaces Automated Entry Processing (AEP) and e-Manifest for Imports





Automated Import System - AIS

All customs import supply chain operators must use software that can interface with AIS





Impact of AIS on Air & Sea Carriers

- Presentation Declaration (G3) & Temporary Storage
 Declaration (G4) lodged into AIS replacing e-Manifest
 declaration in respect of imports of non-union goods only
- ENS (safety & security declaration), where applicable will be lodged into ICS (Import Control System) - ENS cannot be used to generate the G3/G4
- Electronic Transport Document (D3) lodged into AIS where applicable




Supply Chain Communication


- The MRN of the G3/G4 must be included on all declarations releasing goods out of a TSF and into a customs procedure
- Carrier must ensure the MRN of the G3/G4 is communicated directly or indirectly to the entity completing the customs declaration
- Where a customs import declaration is prelodged, the combined G3/G4 should reference the MRN of the pre-lodged declaration. For this to happen there must be good communication between the entity lodging the customs declaration and the carrier
