Subject line: Revenue-Ireland - ROS STR upgrade Communication – go live date for upgrade to ROS STR

Dear ROS MLRO User,

This communication from Revenue-Ireland pertains to the upcoming upgrade to the ROS STR system on 08.00hrs February 18th 2025. (FIU-Ireland GoAML will go live a week earlier on 10th February 2025). If you have not already done so, please ensure you have read **all previous communications** sent to you regarding the upgrade from FIU-Ireland.

The upgrade is progressing on target and the upgrade will **go live for Revenue-Ireland at 08.00 hrs 18**th **February 2025**. We would like to highlight the following key changes to the upgraded version 5.4.2, **point number 3 details the downtime window.**

#	Users affected	Change
1.	ROS MLRO XML upload users	Please ensure you have updated your IT system with the new XML schema (Schema version 5.0.2) by February 16 th , 2025. As previously communicated, the new schema is for the upgraded version of ROS only and is not compatible with the current version 4.5. It is vital that your entity does not implement any changes on the current schema before the downtime date, February 7 th 2025 at 18:00.
2.	ROS MLRO users	 In order to avoid problems with the latest release, we ask the reporting entities to submit the reports that are under 'DRAFTED REPORTS' on the ROS website before 18:00 on February 6th as draft reports in the current ROS version will not be compatible with the upgraded version.
3.	ROS MLRO users	Downtime details: – Start Date: February 7 th 2025 – Start Time: 18:00, GMT

		 End Date: February 18th 2025 End Time: 08:00, GMT ROS will be unavailable for submissions to Revenue-Ireland during the downtime window. Revenue-Ireland are asking all users to download and retain their XML files downloaded from the GoAML portal so that they can upload these to ROS when the ROS portal resumes on the 18th February. Please ensure that you submit your draft reports and log out / save your work prior to the scheduled downtime.
