

# VRT19 - REQUEST TO REVENUE COMMISSIONERS TO AMEND DECLARATION FOR REGISTRATION



Send, using ROS or **myaccount** (MyEnquiries / Vehicle Registration Tax / Registration Amendments & Deletions), with a copy of the registration receipt. If the vehicle has been motor taxed, then send by MyEnquiries, along with the Vehicle Registration Certificate and the registration receipt, to the National VRT Service.

**NB:- S135B(6) Finance Act 1992, as amended, requires an Authorised Person (TAN holder), subject to conditions, to pay any refunded / credited overpayment to the first registered owner. Questions concerning S135B(6) should be addressed to your local Revenue office.**

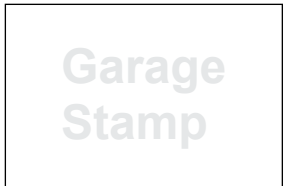
