## 1. Introduction

AES has been implemented in Ireland since 21 March 2023 and has been operating in what is known as 'transitional mode' since that date, as we await AES implementation across all other EU Member States. We are now preparing to move to AES Final Mode and this notification details the transition to that mode.

## 2. Update

As stated in <u>eCustoms notification 26 of 2023</u> the EU Commission Transition Period (TP), rules for AES will end on 11 February 2025.

The changes relate mainly to field format lengths.

Revenue's PIT4 environment will be updated to reflect AES Final Mode from 2 September 2024 which will allow you to test messages with the TP End Date being in the past (for example 31 August 2024). We will reflect this in the Notifications area of the PIT Service Desk Tool.

The end date of the Transition period rules is referred to in the IT specifications as the TPEndDate and it is highly recommended that the TPEndDate is configurable in your systems.
